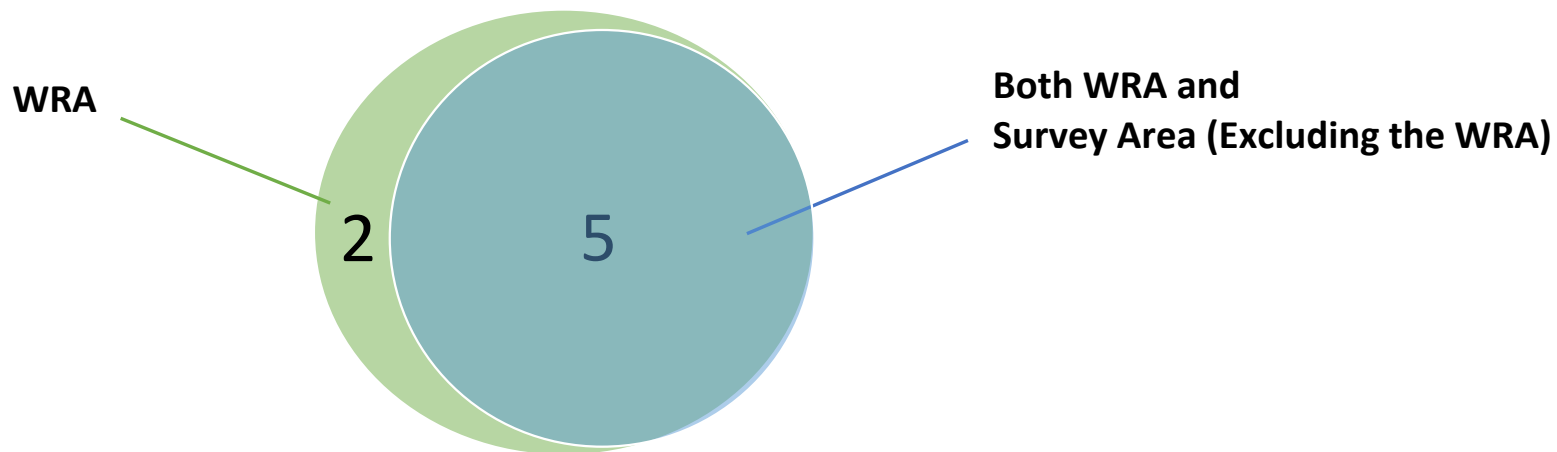

Chart C1: Number of Common Amphibian Species and Amphibian Species Only Found in the WRA or Survey Area (Excluding the WRA) During the Reporting Period

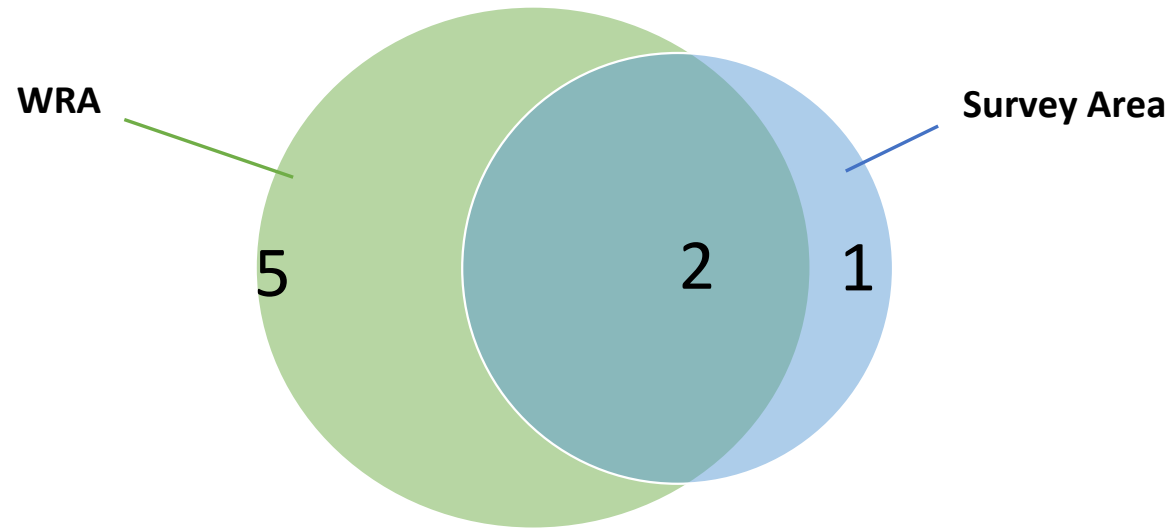

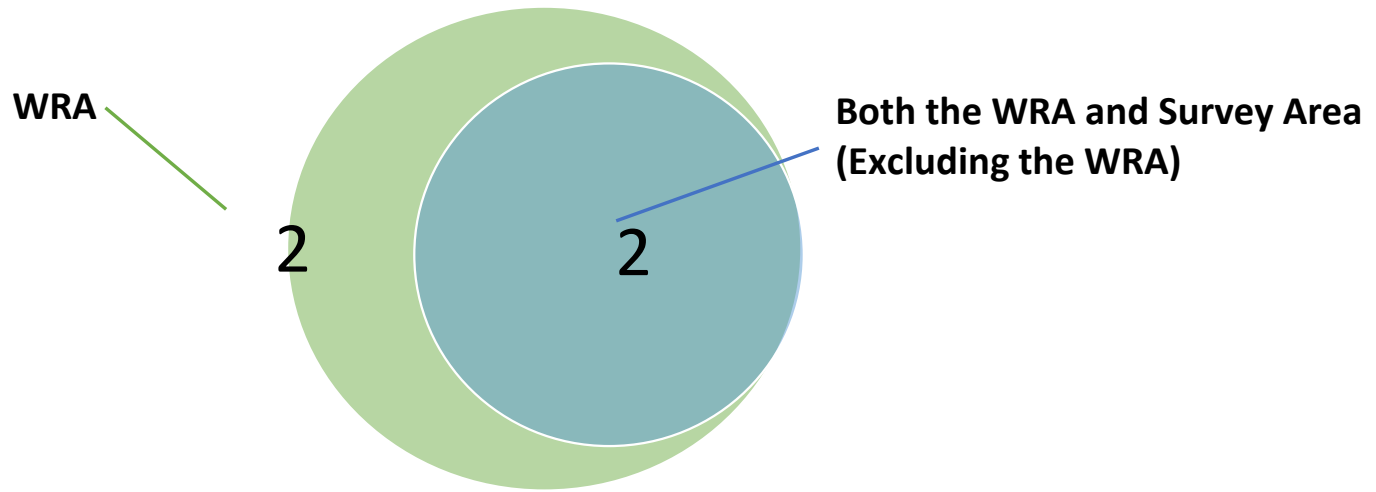

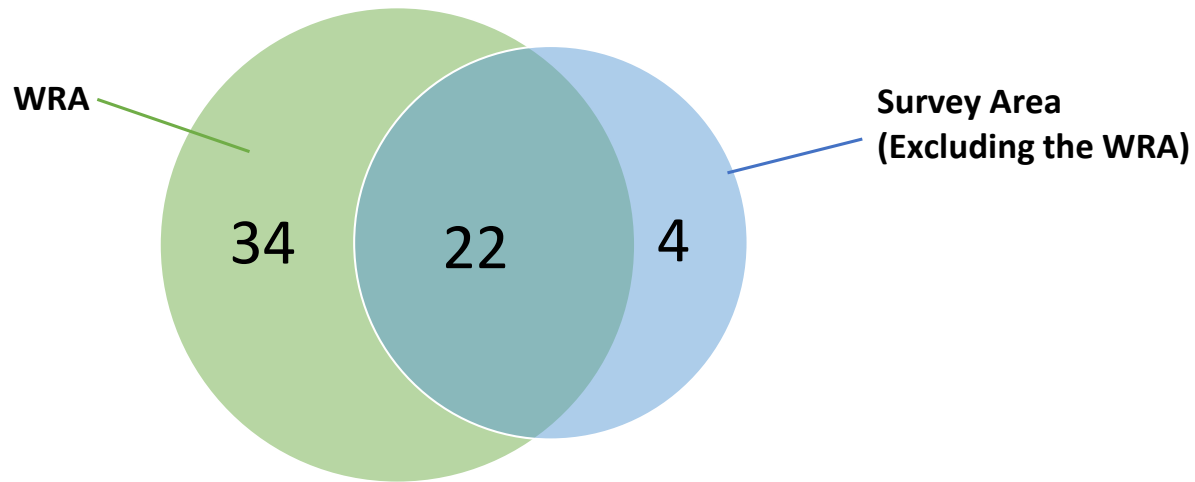
